- Once logged into Availity, select Help & Training > Get Trained.
- The Availity Learning Center opens in a new browser tab.
- Search the catalog by webinar title or a **keyword** to find a session and enroll.
- To find a specific live or recorded session quickly use keywords, for example:
 - Medical attachments Use keyword medattach.
 - O Claims Use key word claims.
- Select the **sessions** tab to scroll the live session calendar or access a recorded webinar.
- After you enroll, you will receive email with instructions on how to join or access the session.

Prior authorization requirements:

- To request or check the status of a prior authorization request or decision for a particular plan member, access our ICR tool via **Availity**. Once logged in, select **Patient Registration | Authorizations & Referrals**, then choose **Authorizations** or **Auth/Referral Inquiry** as appropriate.


